Mike has several high-speed passions in his life. One is motor racing, and another is flying, but the one that drives him day-by-day is the lightning-fast connectivity of electronics and CCTV. As CEO of AD Group and founder of Dedicated Micros, Mike heads a group of companies that stand at the forefront of cutting-edge new technologies. He is widely recognised as one of the UK's leading businessmen and entrepreneurs as well as a very proficient racing driver with more than 25 years racetrack experience.



Mike's interest in motor racing came initially from behind the barriers, as a volunteer marshal. He stepped over the Armco for the first time in 1985 and embarked on a very successful period in Formula Ford that kept him challenged for more than ten years. Then, towards the end of the 1990s, Mike began competing in GT races, mainly with his still-treasured Ford Falcon EL. Appearances in the Bathurst 6 Hour and a class win at the Nürburgring convinced him that his future lay in endurance racing. In 2002 he made his debut in the Daytona 24 Hours and completed a full season in the British GT Championship aboard a Porsche 996 GTR prepared by Graham Nash Motorsport.

That same year GNM also managed the title-winning Saleen S7-R driven by Thomas Erdos, and the arrangement united the two drivers who have raced together ever since. Mike and Tommy's first full season as co-drivers was in 2003, sharing the GNM Saleen in the FIA GT Championship with assistance from RML. Mike also made his debut in the Le Mans 24 Hours. In the autumn of 2003 RML AD Group launched their joint sportscar programme with an appearance in the inaugural LMES 1000 Kilometres using an ex-works MG Lola EX257. Mike competed in the LMP1 EX257 throughout 2004, but switched to LMP2 in 2005 with the MG Lola EX264. The squad took a first LMP2 win in the Le Mans 24 Hours that June, and then repeated the feat in 2006. In 2007 Mike took the Le Mans Series LMP2 title – and again in 2010.
